How to Become a Certified Nurse Aide (CNA) in Texas

1. Complete Nurse Aide Training

- Training Requirements: Finish a state-approved nurse aide training program with 60 hours of classroom and 40 hours of clinical training or the HHSC computer-based training (CBT) with 60 hours of online classroom training and 40 hours of clinical training.
- Register for Face-to-Face Training at Tyler Junior College (TJC): Nurse Aide Training and Competency
 Evaluation Program (NATCEP) training course at TJC, visit https://tjc.edu2.com/category/517/health-professions or call TJC Continuing Studies at 903-510-2900.
 - o The registration fee will be due at this time.
 - Upon successful completion of the Clinical Readiness Evaluation, the student will be added to TJC
 Clinical Rounds (no additional fee required for clinicals).
- Complete the Certified Nurse Aide Program Registration Packet provided by TJC at the time of registration.
 - Complete Criminal Background Check Authorization.
 - Complete or provide proof of immunizations, including TB results.
 - o Provide valid photo identification (State ID or Driver's License)
- Register for Clinicals after completing HHSC computer-based training: Call Tyler Junior College Continuing Studies at 903-510-2900 to register for and schedule your Clinical Readiness Evaluation.
 - Upon successful completion of the Clinical Readiness Evaluation, the student will be added to the CBT Clinical Rounds, and the registration fee will be due.
 - Clinical rounds will be completed at the same facilities and with the same rules and expectations as students attending Tyler Junior College's face-to-face classroom training.

2. Submit an Application through TULIP

- **Application Submission**: After finishing the training, submit a New Nurse Aide by Examination Application in TULIP.
- Create Account: Log in to TULIP to create an account and reset your password if needed.
- Application Review: HHSC staff will review your application. If there are any issues, they will ask you to fix them.

3. Get NATCEP Approval

- Training Approval: The director of your training program must approve your training in TULIP. To be
 eligible for approval, you must:
 - Successfully complete the training.
 - o Pass a background check based on requirements in Texas Health and Safety Code 250.006.
 - Ensure you are not listed on the Employee Misconduct Registry.
 - o Follow all the rules and expectations agreed to on the first day of class.
- **Email Notification**: You will get an email with a link to register for the exam.

4. Schedule and Pass the Exams

- Prometric Scheduling: Prometric handles scheduling and testing. Call 800-488-5787 or email TXCNA.
- **Exam Registration**: Sign up and pass the written and skills exams.
- **Exam Location**: TJC is a Licensed Prometric Testing Facility. Your exam will be held on the TJC West Campus.

5. Get Your Certification

- **Exam Scores**: Your exam scores will be sent to TULIP from the Prometric system.
- **Certificate Issuance**: HHSC staff will issue your certificate and change your application status to "Approved." You will get an email from TULIP.
- Print Certificate: You can print your certificate from TULIP.
